**Landscaping Along Bikeway on Main Street**

Sealed proposals will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Suisun City, 701 Civic Center Blvd, Suisun City, CA, 94585 until **2:00 P.M. on Tuesday, July 20, 2010**, for work in accordance with the project plans and specifications to which special reference is made, as follows:

**Landscaping Along Bikeway on Main Street**

**DESCRIPTION OF WORK:** The work to be done, in general, consists of supplying all labor, materials, tools, equipment, implements and methods of process to complete the following work: removing plants; grading; soil preparation; constructing retaining wall; and planting trees, shrubs and vines; as well as designing and installing irrigation (on a design/build basis) work necessary to construct the improvements shown on the contract plans to the lines and grades contained therein.

Plans and specifications may be inspected at the Department of Public Works, 701 Civic Center Blvd., Suisun City, CA 94585, and may be purchased for **\$50.00** per set. Mailed requests shall be addressed to the Department of Public Works, City of Suisun City, 701 Civic Center Blvd., Suisun City, CA 94585. A postage and handling fee of **\$15.00** shall be added per set of plans and specifications to be mailed. Special arrangements must be made for overnight mail service. Please call the City (707-421-7340) to verify the availability of plans and specifications.

Proposals will be opened and read aloud at 2:00 P.M. at City Hall, on the day specified above.

No pre-bid meeting is scheduled for this project.

**For bonding purposes, the Engineers Estimate Range is from \$55,000.00 - \$70,000.00**

Inquiries or questions based on alleged patent ambiguity of the plans, specifications or estimate must be communicated as a bidder inquiry prior to bid opening. Any such inquiries or questions, submitted after bid opening, will not be treated as a bid protest.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1770 et seq. of the Labor Code of California, the Director of Industrial Relations for the State of California has ascertained the current general prevailing rate of wages for employer purposes, in Solano County, State of California.

In accordance with the State of California Administrative Code Title 8, Group 3, Article 2, Section 16109, Publication of Prevailing rates by Awarding Bodies, copies of the applicable determinations of the Director are on file at the Public Works Department of the City of Suisun City and may be reviewed upon request. If there is a difference between the minimum wage

rates predetermined by the Secretary of Labor and the prevailing wage rates determined by the Department of Industrial Relations for similar classifications of labor, the Contractor and his subcontractors shall pay not less than the higher wage rate.

Pursuant to Section 1773 of the Labor Code, the general prevailing rate of wages in the county in which the work is to be done has been determined by the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations. These wage rates appear in the Department of Transportation publication entitled General Prevailing Wage Rates. Future effective wage rates, which have been predetermined and are on file with the Department of Industrial Relations are referenced but not printed in said publication.

The Contractor shall possess a valid Class "A" or Class "C-27" License at the time the contract is awarded.

Bids are required for the entire work described herein. This contract is subject to State contract, nondiscrimination and compliance requirements pursuant to Government Code, Section 12990.

The successful bidder shall furnish a bid bond, a payment bond and a performance bond. The Contractor and all sub-contractors shall possess a valid Suisun City business license prior to start of work.

The City of Suisun City hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, disadvantaged business and woman owned business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on the grounds of race, color, or national origin in consideration for an award.

The City of Suisun City reserves the right to postpone the date and time for the opening of proposals at any time prior to the date and time announced in the advertisement.

All proposals shall be valid for a period of sixty (60) days after the bid opening. The City of Suisun City reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any defects or informality in the bidding.
