- **Grilling Safety:**
- Fourth of July is a time when families might take the opportunity to head outdoors to barbeque. Take a few safety precautions to ensure that your celebration happens without incident.
- Place the grill out doors at a safe distance from lawn games, play areas and foot traffic. A grill should be at least 10 feet away from the home and overhanging branches.
- Create a 3 foot "kid-free zone" to keep children and pets away from the grill.
- Use long oven/barbeque mitts and long-handled grilling tools to protect the chef from heat and flames when cooking.
- Ensure your grill is in good working condition. Periodically remove grease or fat buildup so it cannot be ignited.
- Check propane hose line for leaks.
- For charcoal grills; make sure coals are completely cooled off before disposing to avoid trash can fires.
