NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

AMENDMENT OF THE CITY OF SUISUN CITY MUNICIPAL CODE REPEALING AND REPLACING CHAPTER 18.47 OF THE SUISUN CITY CODE REGARDING THE REGULATION OF MEDICINAL MARIJUANA

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Suisun City Planning Commission will hold a Public Hearing to consider and make recommendations to the City Council regarding amendments to Chapter 18.47 of the Suisun City Code.

SUMMARY

The proposed Municipal Code amendment would repeal and replace Suisun City Code, Chapter 18.47 of Title 18, relating to regulation of medical marijuana cultivation and deliveries. In light of the recently enacted Medical Marijuana Regulation and Safety Act by the State, the City must establish land use regulations to either prohibit or regulate commercial cannabis activities in order to maintain local authority regarding its regulation within city limits.

The Planning Commission will consider the proposed Municipal Code amendments at a special public meeting at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 17, 2015 at Suisun City Council Chambers, 701 Civic Center Boulevard, Suisun City, California. All interested parties are invited to attend.
