**CITY AGENDA ITEM:** Discussion and Direction on the Grizzly Island Trail Conceptual Plan.

---

**FISCAL IMPACT:** This item would have no fiscal impact.

---

**BACKGROUND:** On July 7, 2009, the City Council authorized the City Manager to use RRM Design to prepare a preliminary design and conceptual plan for the Grizzly Island Trail Project. This project would install a pedestrian/bicycle trail from Grizzly Island Road to Marina Boulevard on the south side of State Route 12. The total project cost is estimated to be \$2,000,000. City staff has secured funding through the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) and the State Safe Routes to School Program (SR2S) to fund this project. Funding for this project has a construction deadline of June 2012.

---

**STAFF REPORT:** RRM Design Group has completed the preliminary design and conceptual plan for the Grizzly Island Trail Project (Attachment 1). The primary intent of this project is to provide a path connecting the Crystal Middle school area to the west with the Crescent Elementary School to the east. Currently students living in each of these areas must cross Highway 12 twice to get to their school in the other area. Student safety is a primary concern of this project. At the same time we would be building a public amenity for family fun, mini school field trips and general public viewing of the wildlife and plants of the area, while also enhancing the view from the highway.

We held two stakeholder meetings on the conceptual plan. The first meeting was in early February in a roundtable format and with a draft concept plan prepared by RRM. The idea behind the meeting was to gather input, ideas, comments and concerns from stakeholders involved. Attendees included representatives from the Fairfield-Suisun Unified School District, utilities, public safety, the Community Development Department, Economic Development Department, Solano Transportation Authority (STA), Department of Fish & Game, AECOM, RRM Design Group, Solano County and STA Pedestrian Advisory Committee members. That first meeting was about two hours long with lots of ideas, comments and concerns. The second meeting was held in late February and was more of a presentation. Here, RRM took all the comments given at the first meeting and came back with a revised conceptual plan, with the project and the ultimate build-out. Attendees were the same as above. The comments from this second meeting were used to refine the concept plan that is attached.

At this time, staff seeks direction from Council on the overall conceptual plan presented to you. Our next step would be to bring back to Council an award of contract for an engineering firm to prepare the final design and construction documents for bidding. That design firm would begin its work from the attached concept plan along with any comments made by the Council.



# Grizzly Island Trail Conceptual Trail Alignment—West End






