MINUTES OF APRIL 4, 2012 MEETING**

Chairman Billy Gaither called the meeting to order at 7:15 p.m.

D. CONSENT CALENDAR

1. Approval of Minutes:

The minutes of March 7, 2012 meeting were approved with a 3-0 vote. Motion to approve made by Commissioner John, seconded by Vice-Chair Lori Wilson.

E. GENERAL BUSINESS

1. Senior Center Update: Mick Jessop stated that the draft Senior Center blueprints are available and the Commissioners can view them after the meeting. The CBDG is looking at all the specs and will need their approval before going out to bid. The Senior Center construction is anticipated to start mid-June with the Senior Center estimated to be closed June, July, and August. All Senior activities will be relocated to the Joseph Nelson Community Center.
2. Suisun Beautification Project: Commissioner John Pierce said that the Suisun City Website will be promoting the Suisun Beautification project with the help of Scott Corey, Suisun City Marketing Manager.
3. Community Services Foundation: Lori Wilson announced that the Community Services Foundation has raised approximately \$30,000 with community donations and a goal of \$60,000 to \$80,000. Some of the larger sponsors to date include PG&E with a \$10,000 matching grant, Basin Street Hospitality/Hampton Inn & Suites, Potrero Hills Landfill, Cast Iron Grill & Bar, and Medic Ambulance.
4. Lawler Ranch Pond Re-Grand Opening in May: A May 5th date is being looked at by the Commissioners for a Re-Grand Opening ceremony for Lawler Ranch Pond. Mick Jessop will contact Jeff Penrod to see if the pond pumps are working properly and the landscaping pruned for a May 5th Re-Grand Opening.

F. REPORTS

1. Staff

- a. City Council Agenda: Mick Jessop reported that City Council will be going forward with the sale of safe and sane fireworks with some of the profits going to next year's event and to qualified non-profits that sell the fireworks. The proposed ordinance stated that non-profit organizations will staff the three firework booths of which there will be an agreed method of profit sharings with the non-profit that will go to the city.
 - b. Park Development Fund: Mick reported that the Finance report was not available and the figures are comparable to last month's report.
 - c. Recreation / Community Center: The Recreation Monthly Report was distributed and discussed.
 - d. Marina Report: The Marina monthly report was distributed and discussed.
 - e. Senior Center Report: The Senior Center April Newsletter and Calendar were discussed. Chairman Billy Gaither announced that the April Senior dinner will be baked ham and the May Senior Dinner will be tri-tip.
 - f. Other: Mick announced that the Alooma Temple will be holding a Community Easter Egg Hunt on April 7th in Heritage Park from 12:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m... The ATOD Prevention Booth, Suisun Library and Travis AFB Drug Demand Reduction will be present along with jumpers, Kelly the Clown, and Suisun Fire Department. The Fire Department's Annual Easter Egg Hunt will take place in Hall Park on Easter Day.
2. Commissioners: Vice-Chair Lori Wilson gave an update with the Suisun City Community Foundations. A question was asked regarding the necessary members that needed to be in attendance at the meetings and Lori discussed the member composition. Lori would like the Community Foundation to be added to the next Parks & Recreation agenda.
 3. Chairman: Chairman Billy Gaither would like Gus Barkas to join the May Parks & Recreation Meeting for the Marina Update.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 7:55 p.m. Motion to adjourn was made by Vice-Chair Lori Wilson and seconded by John Pierce.
