D. CONSENT CALENDAR

Approval of Minutes:

The minutes of March 5, 2014 meeting were approved with a 4-0 vote. Motion to approve made by Commissioner Roger Begley and seconded by Commissioner Tom Conley.

E. GENERAL BUSINESS

1. Lawler Ranch Park Master Plan: Mick Jessop reported that approximately 100-150 residents attended the meeting at Lawler Ranch Park on March 22 with 88 registered participants. Information stations were available and staffed to answer resident's questions. Mick stated that the architects will cover three options. The amount of the initial estimate of the park completion project is \$700,000 with having an approximate \$1.2 million total Park Development budget. The architects will cover monthly maintenance for each item requested by the residents, i.e.: restrooms, trees, dog park, shelter/sunshade. Mick is estimating bringing the recommendations to the Planning Commission and Parks & Recreation Commissions late spring and then take to City Council this summer. Mick stated that the next two meetings will be April 24 and June 5 from 6:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m. at the Joseph Nelson Community Center.
2. Get Out and Park Day: Mick Jessop distributed flyers for Get Out and Park Day and asked for feedback from the Commissioners. With one revision, the flyer was approved for distribution to the public. Chairman Angel Borja said if there is a good turn-out; other city parks could be implemented.

REPORTS

1. Staff
 - a. City Council – Mick Jessop reported that Walmart was discussed at the City Council meeting and an oversized check with the fee amount that Walmart paid to the City was presented. Walmart is estimating a spring 2015 opening which will begin sales tax revenue to also begin being paid in late July 2015
 - b. Park Development Fund – Mick Jessop covered the Park Development Fund.
 - c. Recreation / Community Center – Cathy Rader discussed the monthly report.
 - d. Marina Report – The Marina monthly report was discussed. Mick reported that the Marina has gas fuel tank problems and is currently working on the problem.
 - e. Senior Center Report – The Newsletter and Activities Calendar were distributed. Mick stated that the Senior Dinner attendance has been diminishing and that Karen Mickens is looking at different ways of advertising the dinner to increase attendance. Mick added that the tax prep at the Senior Center was a success.
 - f. Other: None
2. Commission – Commissioner Roger Begley stated that field on Highway 12 was recently mowed and also weed abatement completed. Mick Jessop reported that the City may no longer receive free water and may begin to be charged in 2014-2015. Heritage, Goepf, Hall and Day Parks are estimated to cost \$200,000 for water usage.
3. Vice-chair John Pierce asked what happened to the residents that were interested in improving Montebello Park and Mick stated that he had not heard from them.
