SUISUN CITY TO SWAY WITH ITS RESIDENTS

Once again, facing continued erosion to City services and programs that have been cut to the bone since the Great Recession and numerous State financial grabs, Suisun City launched its SWAY campaign today. The purpose of the effort is to give Suisun City residents a chance to SWAY the direction of the City by sharing their ideas and opinions about the direction the City should move.

The SWAY effort will include multiple avenues for City residents to use to share their insights and desires with City officials, including social media, a photo contest and an on-line survey, which are available through www.Suisun.com/sway. There also will be information at local businesses and government offices that will outline the problems Suisun City faces, and ask for priorities and direction.

A Town Hall Meeting will be held on June 2nd from 6:00pm to 8:00pm at the Kroc Center. All Suisun residents are invited to come and participate, and stay for ice cream and cookies following the meeting.

Some issues to be discussed at the Town Hall Meeting include:

1. What are some steps that the City can do to make life easier for commuters: Keep certain City offices open later a few days a week? What do commuters miss that others can enjoy? How can we make it easier for commuters to still play an active role in the Suisun City community?
2. What is the one thing that Suisun City lacks that frustrates you the most? That causes you to have to go to Fairfield or Vacaville? A dry cleaner? A carwash? A Whole Foods?
3. Can you think of one thing that our Waterfront needs/doesn't have that could kick start it? What would make visitors want to come to our Waterfront?

The first annual "SUISUN CITY – OUR HOMETOWN" photo contest is yet another tool the City is using to connect with residents. Our message: "SWAY...Suisun City. Have YOUR Say."
