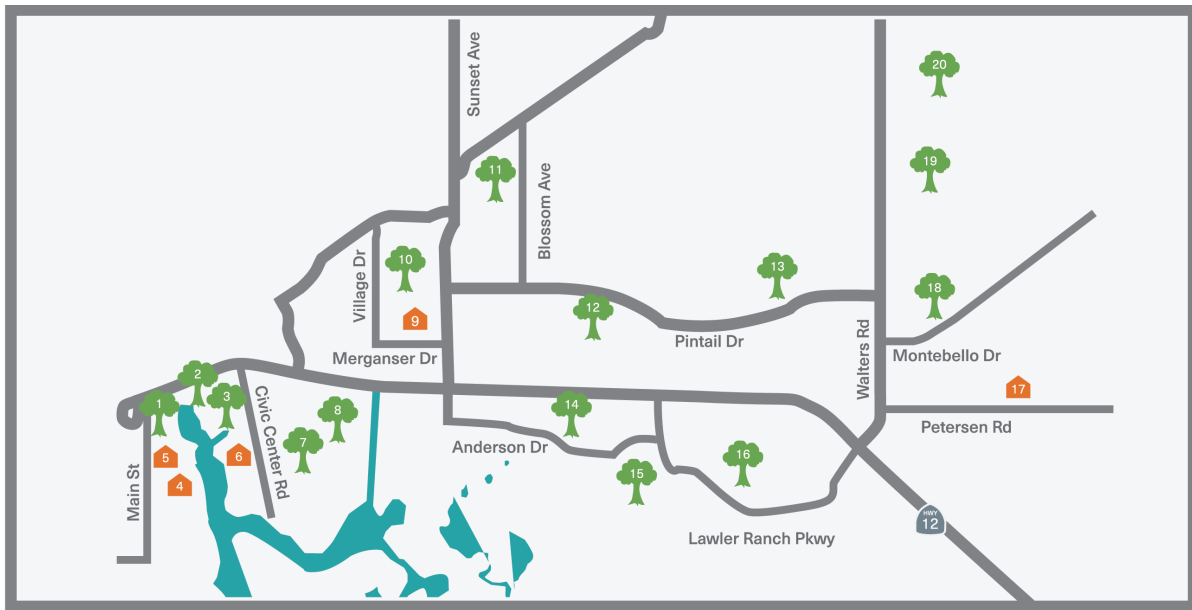

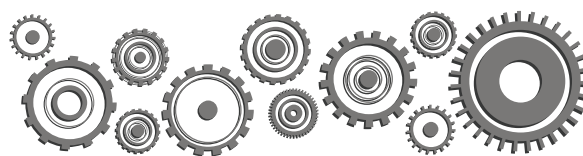

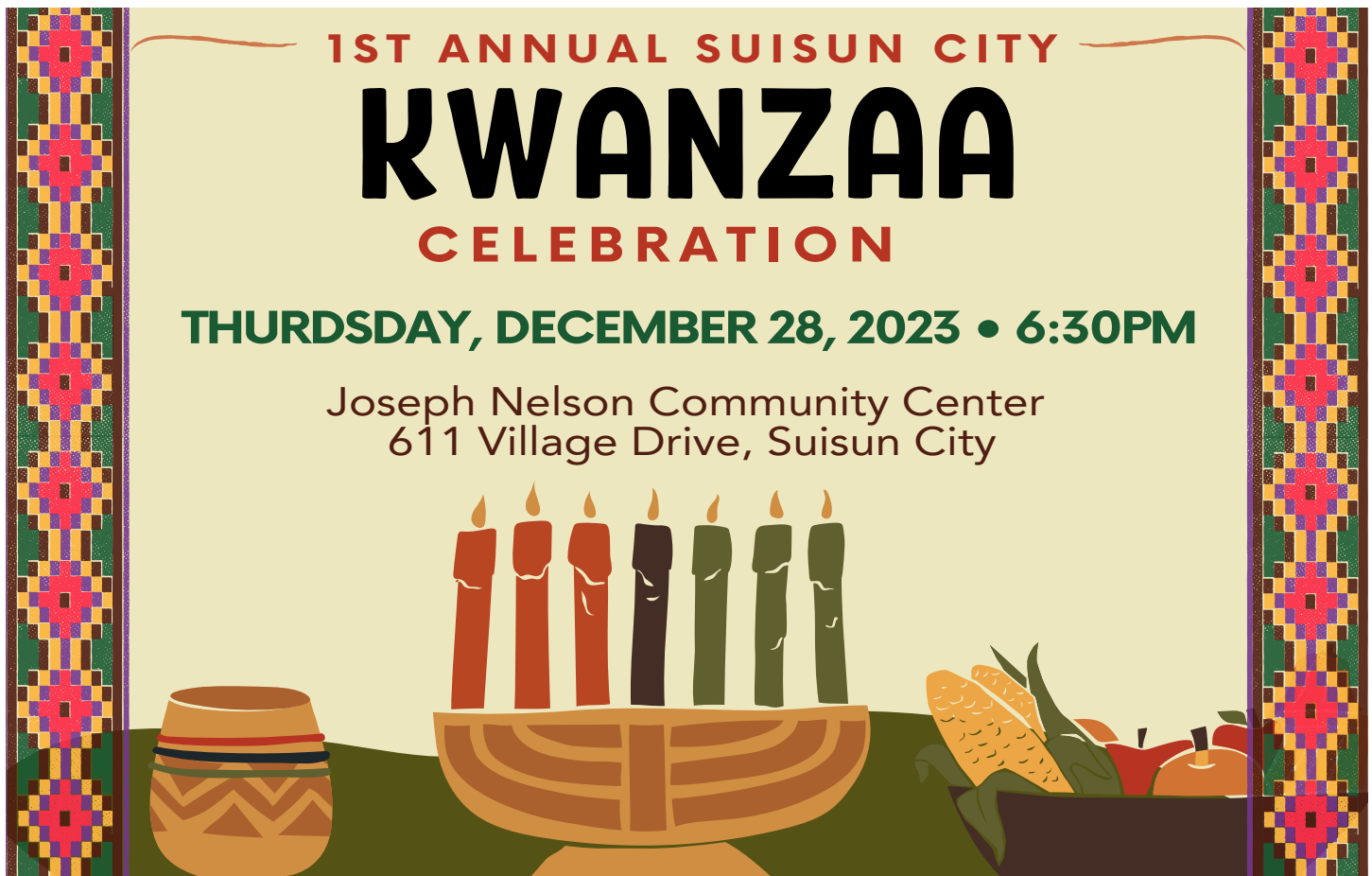
Tuesdays with CARE4EM

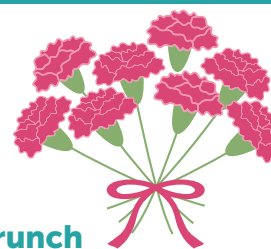
