

CITY OF SUISUN CITY PUBLIC NOTICE OF COMMISSION/COMMITTEE VACANCIES



Notice is hereby given that the City of Suisun City is seeking applications from residents interested in serving on one of the following City Commissions and Committees. Members of Commissions and Committees must be residents of Suisun City and possess a desire to serve the community.

Community Advisory Committees Structure and Vacancies:

- Each Committee will serve as an Advisory Board to both the Council and the Commissions. Once a consensus of the Committee is reached, they will submit any findings, reports or comments to the City Council as needed, no less than bi-annually. All such reports and findings are to be solely advisory in nature. On occasion, the City Council or Commission may direct the Committee to review a particular item and may request a report with a specific date or time certain. In either case, the Committee would be subject to the same regular agenda process for appearing before the City Council or Commission.
- Committee membership will be for two-years, expiring March 31 or every odd numbered year, and determined based on the specific Committee and confirmed by the full City Council.

Citywide Beautification Advisory Committee of Suisun City

The Citywide Beautification Committee is a 7-member board with appointments made by the Mayor and each Councilmember. The Chair and Vice Chair to be selected by vote of the members of the Committee annually.

The Committee's purpose shall enhance the quality of life in the community by focusing on: identifying sites in need of beautification such as public areas and public arts; engage and educate the public on how beautification strengthens our sense of community and pride; coordinate public volunteer clean-up events; work with civic groups and government agencies in rehabilitating public areas; and develop and implement annual Beautification Awards Program.

Environment & Climate Community Advisory Committee

Environment & Climate: 7-member board with each member appointed by a member of the Council, with the Mayor having two appointments. The Chair and 7th member of the Committee will be a current City Council member appointed by the Mayor. The Vice Chair will be selected by vote of the members of the Committee annually.

This Committee centers on the environment and our changing climate including, changing impacts on existing and planned developments, researching initiatives to enhance Suisun City Environmental quality of life; promoting ecotourism in Suisun City while focusing on opportunities for education and sustainability; being a forum for on topic presentations, and review of Environmental Impact Reports prior to Commission or City Council review.

Housing Authority Tenant Commissioners

The Housing Authority Commission is the governing board of the Housing Authority and consists of the five City Council Members and two Tenant Commissioners. Tenant commissioners must be tenants of the Housing Authority and at least one tenant commissioner must be over 62 years of age or older. Interested Housing Authority tenants are encouraged to apply.

Interested residents are encouraged to apply by submitting an application form to the City Clerk stating qualifications and objectives for desiring to be become a member of a Commission or Committee. Applications are being received until appointments are made, which could be as early as August 8, 2023.
