### **Recreation, Parks, Marina and Arts Commission**

The Recreation, Parks, Marina, and Arts (RPMA) Commission is composed of seven commissioners serving staggered four-year terms. The RPMA Commission serves as an advisory body to the City Council, the Recreation, Parks, and Marina Department, and the Public Works Department. It provides input on public parks, recreational facilities and programs, grants, relevant operational policies, unmet needs, beautification of public right-of-ways, and public art opportunities within Suisun City. The RPMA Commission meets at 6:00 p.m. on the first Wednesday of each month in the Council Chambers at Suisun City Hall. There is currently one (1) appointment available on the RPMA Commission, with term of appointment ending in January 2029.

### **Environment and Climate Community Advisory Committee**

Environment & Climate: 7-member board with each member appointed by a member of the Council, with the Mayor having two appointments. The Chair and 7th member of the Committee will be a current City Council member appointed by the Mayor. The Vice Chair will be selected by vote of the members of the Committee annually.

This Committee centers on the environment and our changing climate including, changing impacts on existing and planned developments, researching initiatives to enhance Suisun City Environmental quality of life; promoting ecotourism in Suisun City while focusing on opportunities for education

and sustainability; being a forum for on topic presentations, and review of Environmental Impact Reports prior to Commission or City Council review.

**Housing Authority Tenant Commissioners**

The Housing Authority Commission serves as the governing board of the Housing Authority and is composed of the Mayor, City Council Members, and two Tenant Commissioners. Tenant Commissioners must be residents of the Housing Authority, with at least one commissioner being 62 years of age or older. Housing Authority tenants who are interested are encouraged to apply.
