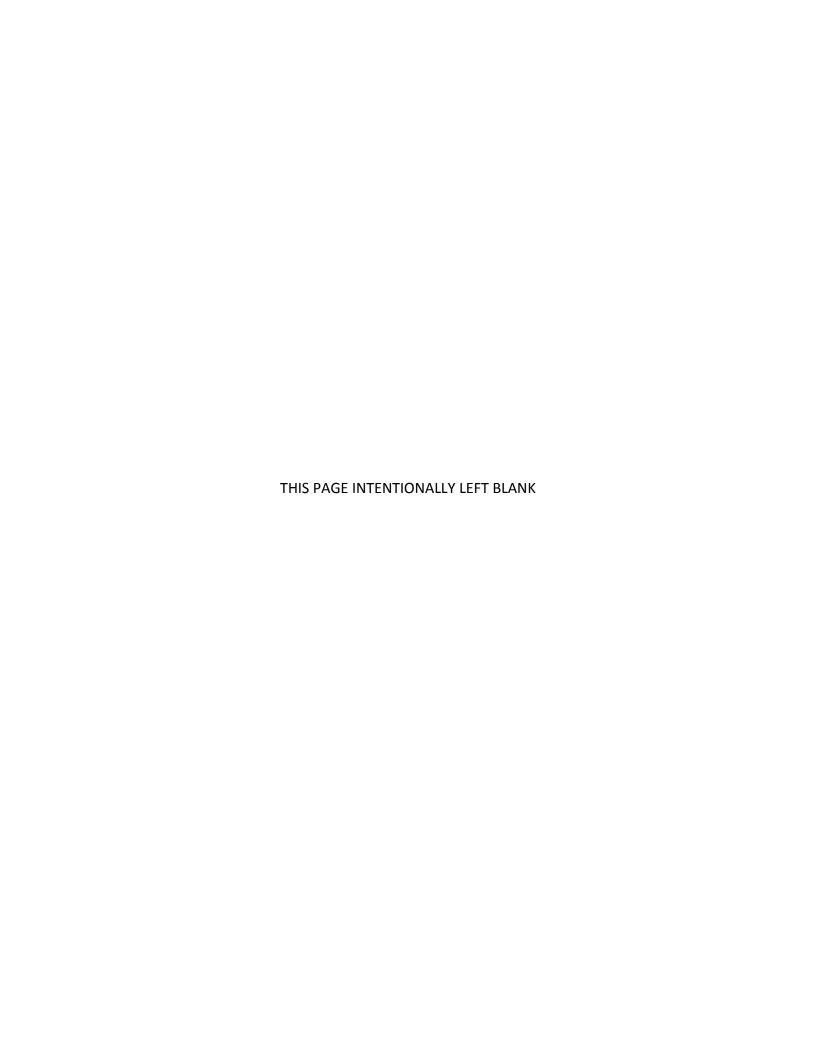

FISCAL IMPACT: None.

**STRATEGIC PLAN:** Provide Good Governance

**BACKGROUND:** A number of laws have changed since the beginning of the COVID pandemic related to the Brown Act as it relates to teleconferenced public meetings, both from Governor Newsom's Executive Orders and recently from the enactment of Assembly Bill 361, which took effect October 1, 2021, allowing continued remote teleconference meetings without traditional Brown Act compliance, provided certain findings can be made related to the ongoing state of emergency and subject to adherence to certain new noticing and public participation requirements.

The City, as all public agencies in California, must now invoke and adhere to AB 361 and its modifications on certain elements of remote public meetings, or else revert to traditional Brown Act compliance. The major change associated with continuing remote meetings under AB 361 is that the public must now be allowed to make comments in real-time during the public comment period, either telephonically or electronically (such as by Zoom). No physical location for public comment need be provided.

The other major change is that all public agencies, if they want to continue to conduct public meetings remotely, must adopt a resolution every 30 days making the findings of necessity to do so and affirming the measures in place to allow remote public comments by the public.

STAFF REPORT: In March of 2020, at the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, Governor Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency in California, and issued Executive Order N-25-20 to facilitate the ability of legislative bodies to meet using remote/virtual platforms to comply with health orders. Since that time, several other Executive Orders have issued that further modified the requirements related to the conduct of teleconferenced meetings and the right of public participation therein during the state of emergency. The Executive Orders collectively operated to remove certain requirements for teleconferenced meetings, including that each teleconference location be accessible to the public, and that members of the public be able to address the legislative body at each teleconference location.

The Executive Orders allowed the City Council and each of the City's legislative bodies, commissions, and committees subject to the Brown Act to modify how meetings were conducted

PREPARED BY: REVIEWED/APPROVED BY: to protect the health and safety of the legislative bodies, staff, and the public, while ensuring the transparency and accessibility for open and public meetings. However, those executive orders expired on October 1, 2021.

On September 16, 2021, Governor Newsom signed AB 361 into law. AB 361 was made effective October 1, 2021, to correspond to the timing of expiration of the executive orders.

AB 361 allows legislative bodies to continue to utilize remote/virtual platforms for meetings during a state of emergency proclaimed by the Governor that includes the City, provided that one of the following three criteria is met with respect to the meeting:

- i) State or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing; or
- ii) The legislative body is meeting for the purpose of determining, by majority vote, whether as a result of the state of emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees; or
- iii) The legislative has previously determined, by majority vote, that, as a result of the state of emergency, meeting in person would present imminent risks to the health or safety of attendees.

## **Initial Findings**

The proclaimed statewide declaration of emergency related to COVID-19 remains in effect. Accordingly, if just one of the three foregoing criteria are met, then the City can conduct meetings remotely pursuant to Government Code § 54953(e) as amended by AB 361, subject to compliance with certain alternative noticing and public participation requirements as detailed below, and in doing so are excused from compliance with the onerous requirements referenced above that would otherwise apply to remote teleconferenced meetings under Government Code§ 54953(b)(3).

## Findings For Continued Reliance on AB 361 (Future Meetings, if needed)

After 30 days following the initial invocation of AB 361, continued reliance on AB 361 for subsequent meetings requires the following:

- 1. Either the "state of emergency" must remain active or state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing; and
- 2. No later than 30 days after teleconferencing for the first time under AB 361 rules, and every 30 days thereafter, the legislative body, by majority vote, finds that it has reconsidered the circumstances of the state of emergency and at least one of the following circumstances exist:
  - a. The state of emergency continues to impact the ability of the members to meet safely in person; or
  - b. State or local officials continue to impose recommended measures to promote social distancing.

#### Rules For Public Participation Under AB 361

If a public agency invokes AB 361, the alternative notice and participation requirements for teleconferenced meetings are as follows:

- 1. No physical location is required for public attendance or public comment. However, the public must be able to access and participate in the meeting through a call-in or an internet-based service, and instructions for how to participate must appear in the posted notices or agenda;
- 2. Teleconferenced meetings must protect the statutory and constitutional rights of the parties and the public;
- 3. The public must be able to attend the meeting via call-in option or internet-based service option;
- 4. Legislative bodies may allow public comments to be submitted prior to a meeting, but must also allow the public to participate in real time through call-in or internet-based service. A legislative body cannot require public comments be submitted in advance of the meeting;
- 5. If there is any disruption of the call-in or internet-based service, the legislative body must suspend the meeting and take no further action until the problem is fixed;
- 6. When providing a public comment period, whether after each item or during a general comment period, a legislative body must allow reasonable time for members of the public to comment, and must also include reasonable time for members to register with the third-party internet website or online platform, if applicable.

These provisions of AB 361 are effective until January 1, 2024. This means these provisions may be invoked any time there is a proclaimed state of emergency by the Governor (e.g., wildfires) and the City Council can make at least one of the enumerated findings.

In light of the continuing COVID-19 emergency, and the continued threats to health and safety posed by indoor meetings with large attendance, staff recommends adoption of the proposed resolution making the findings required to initially invoke AB 361. Doing so will allow the meetings of the City Council and each of the City's legislative bodies to continue to occur by teleconference, without adhering to the teleconferencing requirements set out in Government Code Section 54953(b)(3) that would otherwise apply absent invocation of AB 361.

Continued reliance on AB 361 will require adoption of a new resolution making the required findings every 30 days.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the City Council adopt Resolution No. 2021- \_\_\_\_\_: A Resolution of the City Council of the City of Suisun City proclaiming a local emergency persists and authorizing the transition to use of remote teleconference meeting procedures by City's the legislative bodies, as authorized by government code section 54953(e) et seq., for the initial period of October 19, 2021 through November 18, 2021.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUISUN CITY PROCLAIMING A LOCAL EMERGENCY PERSISTS AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSITION TO USE OF REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETING PROCEDURES BY CITY'S THE LEGISLATIVE BODIES, AS AUTHORIZED BY GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 54953(E) ET SEQ., FOR THE INITIAL PERIOD OF OCTOBER 19, 2021 THROUGH NOVEMBER 18, 2021

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Suisun City is committed to preserving and nurturing public access, transparency, observation and participation in its meetings and the meetings of each of its legislative bodies; and

**WHEREAS**, all meetings of the City's legislative bodies are open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act, codified as Government Code sections 54950 *et seq.*, so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and observe the City's legislative bodies conduct their business; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, as amended by Assembly Bill 361 (2021), amending Government Code section 54953(e) *et seq.*, allows for remote teleconferencing observation and participation in meetings by members of a legislative body and members of the public, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the initial required condition is a declaration of a state of emergency by the Governor pursuant to the California Emergency Services Act, Government Code section 8625, proclaiming the existence of conditions of disaster or of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property within the state and within the boundaries of the City, as provided in Government Code section 8558; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 4, 2020, pursuant to Government Code Section 8625, Governor Newsom declared the existence of a state of emergency for the State of California, in response to the outbreak of respiratory illness due to a novel coronavirus (a disease now known as COVID-19); and

**WHEREAS**, on March 16, 2020, the City's Director of Emergency Services declared a local emergency for the City pursuant to Chapter 2.32 of the Suisun City Municipal Code, finding that conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons and property have arisen within the City as a result of the COVID-19 virus and that these conditions are or are likely to be beyond the control of the services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City; and

**WHEREAS**, on March 17, 2020, the City Council adopted Resolution No. 2020-40, ratifying the Director of Emergency Services' declaration of local emergency; and

**WHEREAS**, Government Code section 54953(e) further requires that state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing; or, the legislative body of the City finds that meeting in person would present imminent risk to the health and safety of attendees; and

**WHEREAS**, the Council hereby finds that such emergency conditions now exist in the City, such that meeting in person for the meetings of the legislative bodies of the City would present imminent risk to the health and safety of attendees as a result of the increased risk of the spread of the COVID-19 virus among those in attendance; and

WHEREAS, the Council hereby finds that the state of emergency due to the COVID-19 virus and the conditions related thereto has caused, and will continue to cause, conditions of extreme peril to the safety of persons within the City that are likely to be beyond the control of services, personnel, equipment, and facilities of the City, and thereby affirms, authorizes, and proclaims that the existence of a local emergency persists throughout the City, and ratifies the proclamation of state of emergency by the Governor of the State of California; and

<b>FISCAL IMPACT:</b> The sale of these properties will provide some proceeds to the Successor Agency although the proceeds will be relatively low.
STRATEGIC PLAN IMPACT: Develop Sustainable Economy; Provide Good Governance.
<b>BACKGROUND:</b> In 2014, the California Department of Finance (DOF) denied a request to transfer the property to the City after a quitclaim had already been completed. In 2017 the DOF approved the future sale of the property by the Successor Agency which reinforced the need to transfer the property back to the Successor Agency. On September 7, 2021, the Successor Agency of the Former Redevelopment Agency of the City of Suisun City took action to declare the property located at 1240 Kellogg Street (APN: 0032-200-330) as surplus.
<b>STAFF REPORT:</b> Following the September 7, 2021, action, it was determined that title of the property was still in the name of the City versus the Successor Agency which needs to be corrected prior to disposal of the property. To accomplish this, the City Council and Successor Agency are being asked to adopt a resolution to approve the transfer of the property through a quitclaim.
<b>STAFF RECOMMENDATION:</b> It is recommended that the City Council and Successor Agency adopt:

**WHEREAS**, the Property was never transferred back to the Successor Agency, and the Successor Agency and City now desire to quitclaim the Property back to the Successor Agency, and the Successor Agency desires to accept the quitclaim deed, in compliance with Resolution No. OB2017-01 and the DOJ's determination.

## **GRANT DEED**

FOR A VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the SUISUN CITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY, a public body corporate and politic, acting under the Community Redevelopment Law of the State of California, herein called "Grantor," hereby grants to the CITY OF SUISUN CITY, herein called "Grantee," the real property referred to as <u>Assessor's Parcel No. 0032-200-330</u>, hereinafter referred to as the "Site," in the City of Suisun City, County of Solano, State of California, more particularly described in Attachment No. 1 attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

As conditions of this conveyance, the Grantee covenants by and for itself and any successors-in-interest for the benefit of Grantor as follows:

#### 1. Non-Discrimination.

Grantee covenants that there shall be no discrimination against, or segregation of, any persons, or group of persons, on account of race, color, creed, religion, sex, marital status, age, physical or mental disability, ancestry, or national origin in the rental, sale, lease, sublease, transfer, use, occupancy, or enjoyment of the Site, or any portion thereof, nor shall Grantee, or any person claiming under or through Grantee, establish or permit any such practice or practices of discrimination or segregation with reference to the selection, location, number, use, or occupancy of purchasers, tenants, lessees, subtenants, sublessees, or vendees of the Site or any portion thereof. The nondiscrimination and nonsegregation covenants contained herein shall remain in effect in perpetuity.

## 2. Form of Nondiscrimination Clauses in Agreements.

Grantee shall refrain from restricting the rental, sale, or lease of any portion of the Site on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, sex, marital status, age, physical or mental disability, ancestry, or national origin of any person. All such deeds, leases, or contracts shall contain or be subject to substantially the following nondiscrimination or nonsegregation clauses:

- (a) <u>Deeds</u>: In deeds the following language shall appear: "The grantee herein covenants by and for itself, its heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, and all persons claiming under or through them, that there shall be no discrimination against or segregation of any person or group of persons on account of race, color, creed, religion, sex, marital status, age, physical or mental disability, ancestry, or national origin in the sale, lease, sublease, transfer, use, occupancy, tenure, or enjoyment of the premises herein conveyed, nor shall the grantee or any person claiming under or through him or her, establish or permit any such practice or practices of discrimination or segregation with reference to the selection, location, number, use, or occupancy of tenants, lessees, subtenants, sublessees, or vendees in the premises herein conveyed."
- (b) <u>Leases</u>: In leases the following language shall appear: "The lessee herein covenants by and for himself or herself, his or her heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, and all persons claiming under or through him or her, and this lease is made and accepted upon and subject to the following conditions: "that there shall be no discrimination against or segregation of any person or group of persons on account of race, color, creed, religion, sex, marital status, age, physical or mental disability, ancestry, or national origin in the leasing, subleasing, renting, transferring, use, occupancy, tenure, or enjoyment of the land herein leased nor shall the lessee himself or herself, or any person claiming under or through him or her, establish or permit any such practice or practices of discrimination or segregation with reference to the selection, location, number, use, or occupancy of tenants, lessees, sublessees, subtenants, or vendees in the land herein leased."
- (c) <u>Contracts</u>: In contracts the following language shall appear: "There shall be no discrimination against or segregation of any person or group of persons on account of race, color, creed, religion, sex, marital status, age, physical or mental disability, ancestry, or national origin in the sale, lease, rental, sublease, transfer, use, occupancy, tenure, or enjoyment of the land, nor shall the transferee himself or herself, or any person claiming under or through him or her, establish or permit any such practice or practices of discrimination or segregation with reference to the selection, location, number, use, or occupancy of tenants, lessees, subtenants, sublessees, or vendees of the land."

### 3. Covenants to Run With the Land.

The covenants contained in this Deed shall be construed as covenants running with the land and not as conditions which might result in forfeiture of title, and shall be binding upon Grantee, its heirs, successors and assigns to the Site, whether their interest shall be fee, easement, leasehold, beneficial or otherwise. The foregoing covenants shall remain in effect in perpetuity.

A RESOLUTION OF THE OVERSIGHT BOARD TO THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SUISUN CITY RECONSIDERING AND RATIFYING THE TRANSFER OF CERTAIN GOVERNMENTAL PURPOSE ASSETS TO THE CITY OF SUISUN CITY AND DIRECTING THE SUCCESSOR AGENCY TO DISPOSE OF CERTAIN ASSETS

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature enacted Assembly Bill 1X26 (the "Dissolution Act") to dissolve redevelopment agencies formed under the Community Redevelopment Law (Health and Safety Code Section 33000 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Health and Safety Code §34173, the City Council of the City of Suisun City (the "City Council") declared that the City of Suisun City (the "City") would act as successor agency (the "Successor Agency") for the dissolved Redevelopment Agency of the City of Suisun City (the "Dissolved RDA") effective February 1, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Dissolution Act provides for the appointment of an oversight board (the "Oversight Board") with specific duties to approve certain Successor Agency actions pursuant to Health and Safety Code §34180 and to direct the Successor Agency in certain other actions pursuant to Health and Safety Code §34181; and

WHEREAS, prior to and following enactment of the dissolution laws, the former Redevelopment Agency transferred various assets to the City of Suisun City that were constructed and used for a governmental purpose; and

WHEREAS, Health and Safety Code Section 34181 provides the Oversight Board shall "dispose of all assets and properties of the former redevelopment agency; provided, however, that the oversight board may instead direct the successor agency to transfer ownership of those assets that were constructed and used for a governmental purpose, such as roads, school buildings, parks, police and fire stations, libraries, parking facilities and lots dedicated solely to public parking, and local agency administrative buildings, to the appropriate public jurisdiction pursuant to any existing agreements relating to the construction or use of such an asset...; and

**WHEREAS,** on June 24, 2014, the Oversight Board adopted a resolution ratifying the Governmental Purpose Asset transfers; and

**WHEREAS**, the DOF made a determination disallowing the transfer of seven parcels, identified on Exhibit A, attached hereto, and returned to the Oversight Board for reconsideration; and

WHEREAS, the Oversight Board reconsidered the properties identified in Exhibit A as part of the Long Range Property Management Plan it approved on November 13, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Long Range Property Management Plan was never, and will never be approved by the Department of Finance (DOF) due to litigation that prohibited the necessary Finding of Completion from the DOF; and

WHEREAS, the Successor Agency adopted a resolution requesting the Oversight Board reconsider certain Governmental Purpose determinations and ratify the transfer of the properties identified in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the City Adopted a resolution authorizing transfer of certain properties back to the Successor Agency identified in Exhibit A for future sale.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Oversight Board to the Successor Agency does resolve as follows:

**Section 1.** The Recitals set forth above are true and correct and incorporated herein by reference.

**Section 2.** The Oversight Board hereby ratifies the transfer of certain Governmental Purpose Assets identified in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

**Section 3.** The Oversight Board hereby directs the Successor Agency to dispose of the three "Future Sale" parcels identified in Exhibit A, attached hereto.

Subject: Oversight Board Action Determination

The Suisun City Successor Agency (Agency) notified the California Department of Finance (Finance) of its Oversight Board (OB) Resolution on April 6, 2017. Pursuant to Health and Safety Code (HSC) section 34179 (h), Finance has completed its review of the OB action.

Based on our review and application of the law, OB Resolution No. OB 2017-01, approving the transfer of four governmental purpose assets to Suisun City (City) and approving the sale of three properties, is partially approved. The following table outlines our determinations concerning the disposition of the properties:

HSC section 34181 (a) (1) gives the OB the authority to direct the Agency to transfer ownership of assets that were constructed and used for governmental purposes to the appropriate public jurisdiction. The Courtyard and East and West Kellogg Parking Lots fit the definition of use for governmental purposes; therefore, these properties are approved for transfer to the City. However, our review of the Lawler House property indicates the second floor is leased to four small businesses. Therefore, the property does not meet the definition of use for governmental purposes pursuant to HSC Section 34181 (a) and is ineligible for transfer to the City.

Our approval of the future sale of three properties is based on our understanding the Agency intends to remit the sales proceeds for these properties to the County Auditor-Controller to be distributed to the affected taxing entities. HSC section 34177 (e) directs agencies to dispose of assets expeditiously and in a manner aimed at maximizing value. Therefore, the Agency is

encouraged to obtain appraisals to maximize the property value prior to the disposition of these properties. Further, agreements related to the sale of properties should be approved by the OB.

In the event the OB desires to amend the portion of the resolution not approved by Finance, Finance is returning it to the board for reconsideration. However, the Agency may move forward with the portion of the resolution approved by Finance.

**MEETING DATE:** October 19, 2021

**CITY AGENDA ITEM:** HEARING: Adoption of Council Resolution No. 2021-\_\_\_: Placing Liens for Unpaid Waste Collection Service Charges on Certain Lands Situated in the City of Suisun City, County of Solano, State of California.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Republic Services, Inc. is requesting that the City Council place liens on 255 delinquent solid waste accounts representing approximately \$79,077.35 in uncollected solid waste collection service charges. The City's General Fund will receive twenty dollars per lien and 1.0 percent of the total levy amount to be used as the recording fee and to offset the administrative costs associated with the lien and levy process. Through the lien and levy process, the City will collect on outstanding franchise fees totaling 10.0 percent of the uncollected solid waste service charges when the money actually is received.

STRATEGIC PLAN IMPACT: Provide Good Governance, Ensure Fiscal Solvency.

**BACKGROUND:** Republic Services, Inc. provides solid waste collection service for properties located in the City of Suisun City. The Suisun City Code (SCC) Section 8.08.015 requires subscribers to pay the collection charge directly to Republic Services, Inc. In the event that a customer does not pay the collection charges, Republic Services, Inc. must prepare delinquent notices to notify each customer that the account is delinquent and could be subject to a lien/levy process whereby charges would be recorded against the property.

Republic Services, Inc. began actively pursuing collection of delinquent accounts in December 2001. Republic Services, Inc. will request hearings three times per year in order for the Suisun City Council to consider enforcing the lien/levy process for delinquent waste charges.

**STAFF REPORT:** Republic Services, Inc. customers were compared with the owners of record to the parcel information database obtained from Solano County property records. Notification letters were mailed to all known property owners advising them of the lien and levy process. The letters informed the property owners that they could present their reasons for disputing the waste collection charges by either attending the hearing, or by sending letters to the Council prior to the hearing.

Republic Services, Inc. is asking that the City enforce SCC Section 8.08.170 by placing a special assessment/levying a lien on the properties that have delinquent charges. Republic Services, Inc. will verify accounts for payments prior to recording the special assessments.

### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Conduct a Hearing on the proposed liens; and
- Adopt Resolution No. 2021-\_\_\_: Placing Liens for Unpaid Waste Collection Service Charges on Certain Lands Situated in the City of Suisun City, County of Solano, State of California.

**CITY AGENDA ITEM:** PUBLIC HEARING: Council Decision to Implement a Major Service Change to Fairfield and Suisun Transit Fixed Route and Taxi Services within Suisun City effective January 1, 2022, and Approval of Suisun City Council Resolution No. 2021-\_\_\_: Approving FY 2021-22 Transportation Development Act and American Rescue Plan of 2021 Fund Allocations to the City of Fairfield for Operation of Fairfield and Suisun Transit

**FISCAL IMPACT:** Fairfield and Suisun Transit (FAST) service is primarily funded through State Transportation Development Act (TDA) funding and does not impact the General Fund.

**STRATEGIC PLAN IMPACT:** Provide Good Governance, Ensure Fiscal Solvency

**BACKGROUND:** Fairfield and Suisun Transit (FAST) is operated by the City of Fairfield. Since 1990, Suisun City has partnered with the City of Fairfield to provide local transit services linking Fairfield and Suisun City. Suisun City has historically utilized its annual allocation of Transportation Development Act (TDA) to fund FAST services. Current FAST services provided within Suisun City include:

- FAST Route 5 (operates solely within Suisun City),
- FAST Route 6 (operates within Suisun City and Fairfield), and the
- Local Reduced Taxi Program (subsidized for qualifying low-income and elderly residents).

At its August 17, 2021 meeting, the City Council voted to reallocate use of its annual TDA funding and discontinue funding of FAST Route 5, Route 6, and local reduced taxi services effective January 1, 2022. Because there will be a full reduction of fixed route services, FAST is required by the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to follow its fare and service change policy that is part of its Title VI Plan. Because FAST receives federal operating funds that are matched dollar for dollar by Suisun City and Fairfield's TDA funding, Suisun City is also subject to these overall federal transit requirements and impacts. FAST also requires a resolution from the Suisun City Council approving FAST final TDA allocations and one-time American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARPA) funding FAST will claim for services provided to Suisun City during FY 2021-22.

**STAFF REPORT:** When undergoing major service changes, the Federal Transit Administration requires FAST follow policies outlined in FAST's Title VI Plan. Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in any program or activity that receives Federal funds or other Federal financial assistance. FAST's Title VI fare and service policy requires a public hearing be held when more than 25% of revenue miles, revenue hours, or ridership on any individual route are proposed to change.

On August 17, 2021, the City Council considered two options and chose to reduce FAST fixed route service funding by 100% on Routes 5 and 6. Routes 5 and 6 operate within Suisun City and/or Fairfield. City Council will instead focus future TDA funding on implementing microtransit. In the interim, City Council proposes to partner with the Solano Transportation Authority (STA) to

The City Council also chose to discontinue funding FAST's local reduced taxi program. At the hearing, the public will be provided opportunity to comment on community impacts related to City Council's decisions.

Following the public hearing, City Council will consider approving a resolution that includes both Suisun City TDA (\$330,140) and ARPA (\$500,000) funding FAST will claim to operate six months (July-December 2021) of fixed route and taxi service and a full fiscal year (July 2021-June 2022) of DART paratransit service on behalf of Suisun City residents. Since the August 17 City Council action, the Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) notified FAST that Suisun City's FY 2019-20 TDA was reduced by \$72,885 due to insufficient sales tax generation. This resulted in FAST initially covering these expenses on Suisun City's behalf. Since Suisun City does not have surplus from prior year TDA allocations, this \$72,885 needs to be repaid to the City of Fairfield from Suisun City's FY 2021-22 allocation. The total amount of FY 2021-22 Suisun City TDA and ARPA funding FAST will claim is \$903,025 (\$403,025 TDA, \$500,000 ARPA).

# **RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the City Council:

- 1. Open the Public Hearing; and
- 2. Take Public Comment; and
- 3. Close the Public Hearing; and
- 4. Adopt Resolution No. 2021-\_\_\_: Approving FY 2021-22 Transportation Development Act and American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 Fund Allocations to the City of Fairfield for Operation of Fairfield and Suisun Transit
