WHEREAS, the City of Suisun City and its first responders are committed to ensuring the safety and security of all those living in and visiting our city; and

WHEREAS, fire is a serious public safety concern both locally and nationally, and homes are the locations where people are at greatest risk from fire; and

WHEREAS, home fires caused 2,580 civilian deaths in the United States in 2020, according to the National Fire Protection Association® (NFPA®), and fire departments in the United States responded to 356,500 home fires; and

WHEREAS, smoke alarms sense smoke well before you can, alerting you to danger in the event of fire in which you may have as little as 2 minutes to escape safely; and

WHEREAS, Suisun City residents who have planned and practiced a home fire escape plan are more prepared and will therefore be more likely to survive a fire; and

WHEREAS, Suisun City residents that are responsive to public education measures are better able to take personal steps to increase their safety from fire, especially in their homes; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Fire Prevention WeekTM theme, "Fire won't wait. Plan your escapeTM," effectively serves to remind residents it is important to have a home fire escape plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Alma Hernandez, Mayor Pro Tem for the City of Suisun City do hereby proclaim October 9 – 15, 2022 as

"NATIONAL FIRE PREVENTION WEEK"

in Suisun City and urge all citizens to plan and practice a home fire escape and to support the many public safety activities and efforts of fire and emergency services.
