City Manager Folsom presented a presentation on an update with Suisun City regarding the newly elected City Council, important upcoming council items, significant occurrences that happened in Suisun City and important financial information.

Committee Member Pisching asked a clarifying question on the PPP funding.

City Manager Folsom and Chief Lopez answered.

Finance Director Deol presented a presentation on the Measure S Sales and Use Transaction/Use Tax for the Fiscal Year 2022 and 2023 as well as mid-year adjustments.

- Positions that are currently covered by ARPA but will be moving to Measure S funds at midyear: Fire Marshal, Fire Division Chief, Fire Captain, and Fire Engineer.
- Fiscal Year 2021-22 expenditures were budgeted at \$3.9 million, and all funds were spent to meet those expenditures.
- Fiscal Year 2023 had an adopted budget with total resources of \$3.7 million with \$1.2 million received in Sales Tax.
- Total expenditure with personnel is \$2.7 million.
- The funds not spent last year are being carried over with adjustments to the revenue. There is expected to be an increase in sales tax projected revenue.
- One-time expenditures have an ending balance of \$682,843 that will be carried over to cover the costs of the beautification project.
- Project costs with the Fire Department will be carried over to the next fiscal year.

Committee Member Colden asked a clarifying question regarding the Fire Department positions being carried over to Measure S funds.

Finance Director Deol answered the clarifying question.

Committee Member Pisching asked clarifying questions regarding staffing with Police and Fire and the effect of the sunset of Measure S funds.

City Manager Folsom answered.

Chairperson Forney expressed the importance of continuing Measure S funds.

6 Discussion of Future Agenda Items, Meeting Dates, and Similar Administrative Matters.

Finance Director Deol stated there will be a meeting in either April or May for the Fiscal Year Budget Prep to bring the proposed budget for FY 2024 to the Committee before it goes to the City Council.

Committee Member Pisching asked clarifying questions on the gas tax revenue, the Community Services Officer position, reporting issues through MyCivic, and the enforcement that will be made on reported issues.

Committee Member Colden asked a clarifying question regarding Code Enforcement.

Finance Director Deol and City Manager Folsom answered clarifying questions.

Committee Member Pisching motioned to accept the auditor report for the fiscal year 2021-22 and Committee Member Colden seconded. Motion passed by the following vote:
