The Nomination Papers must contain an affidavit of the nominee that he or she will accept the office if elected. Contact your city clerk regarding filing fee.</p> <p>A candidate may circulate his or her own nomination petition, or the candidate may appoint a circulator. Circulators of nomination petitions must be 18 years of age or older and may obtain signatures only from registered voters residing within the district.</p>

(Deadlines are extended to the next business day when they fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or an official state holiday, except for the weekend before an election.)
