NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Suisun City is seeking qualified applicants to fill three (3) vacancies on the Suisun City Recreation, Parks, Marina and Arts (RPMA) Commission. Appointments are to fill one (1) unscheduled vacancy, term ending January 2021; and two (2) appointments for four-year terms each, expiring January 5, 2023. Interested residents are encouraged to apply.

RECREATION, PARKS, MARINA AND ARTS COMMISSION

The City Council recently adopted an Ordinance expanding the Recreation, Parks and Marina Commission to include Arts, including performing arts, public art, visual art, spoken word, literary art, and other art forms to enhance the community. The Recreation, Parks, Marina and Arts Commission consists of seven members appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council. RPMA Commission is an advisory board to the Recreation, Parks and Marina Department, Public Works Department and the City Council regarding all matters relating to parks, recreation programs, grants, operational policies as applicable to parks and recreation, the marina, community art and cultural affairs, and recreational facilities under direction of either department. RPMA Commission meetings are scheduled on the first Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m. Additional meetings may be scheduled as necessary on the third Wednesday of the month.

Applicants must be residents of the City of Suisun City during their term of office. Interested residents may apply by submitting an application form to the City Clerk stating qualifications and objectives for desiring to be become a member of the Recreation, Parks, Marina and Arts Commission. Those with an arts background are strongly encouraged to apply.

Please submit application and supplemental questionnaire no later than Wednesday, May 29, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. Applications can be submitted in person, mailed, or emailed to dpock@suisun.com.

Appointees must file a Statement of Economic Interests, Form 700, with the City Clerk within thirty (30) days of assuming office as mandated by California State Law and complete required AB 1234 Ethics Training. In accordance with the Public Records Act, applications and attachments submitted are considered public records and are subject to disclosure upon receipt of a public records request.
