NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Suisun City is seeking qualified applicants to fill two (2) unscheduled vacancies on the Suisun City Recreation, Parks, Marina and Arts Commission.

- One appointment - term is for the period ending January 2021
- One appointment – term is for the period ending January 2023

The Recreation, Parks, Marina & Arts (RPMA) Commission consists of seven members appointed by the Mayor and approved by the City Council. The RPMA Commission is an advisory board to the Recreation, Parks and Marina Department, Public Works Department and the City Council regarding all matters relating to parks, recreation programs, grants, operational policies as applicable to parks and recreation, the marina, community art and cultural affairs, and recreational facilities under direction of either department. RPMA Commission meetings are scheduled on the first Wednesday of each month at 7:00 p.m.

The application period has been extended, appointment of two RPMA Commissioners is scheduled for October 6, 2020. Applicants must be residents of Suisun City during their term of office. Interested residents may apply by submitting an application to the City Clerk stating qualifications and objectives for desiring to become a member of the RPMA Commission. **Completed applications for the two vacancies must be returned to the City Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 24, 2020.** Applications and supplemental questionnaire are available at <https://www.suisun.com/government/citizen-governance/>.
