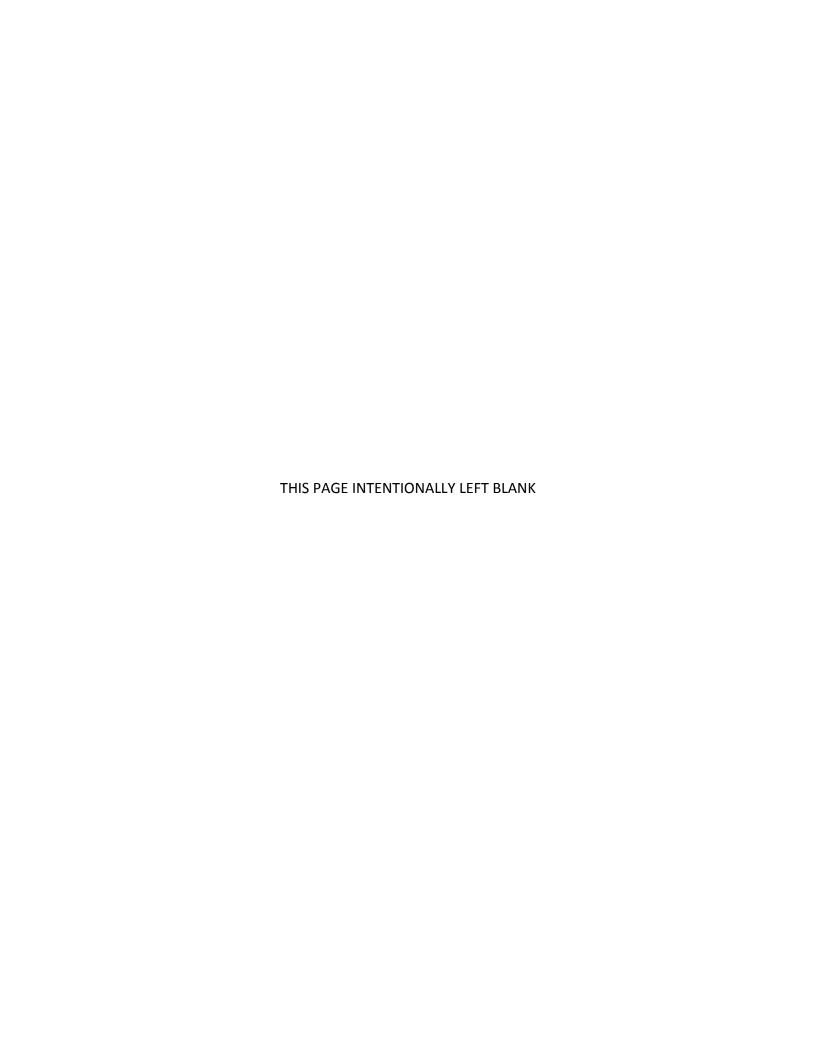

The PICH goals for 2016 include:

- Build on the year-one activities to create a sustainable working committee to lead the efforts.
- Work with this group to identify strategies and other individuals or groups who will implement these strategies.
- Begin the implementation of these strategies.
- Explore the viability of and implementation of recognition programs.
- Develop incentive programs to encourage businesses to provide smoke-free, healthy food and beverage options.
- Identify opportunities for incorporating health indicators and chronic disease prevention principles into City plans.
- Review City standards to identify opportunities for enhancements related to PICH goals.
- Work with the County and the media contractor as needed to ensure the use of all appropriate forms of media related to the goals.

The City's PICH budget for 2016 would be as follows:

 Staff costs including fringes 	\$ 34,242
 Operating Expenses 	21,967
 Subcontractor expenses 	81,000
 Indirect expenses 	13,721
TOTAL	\$150,930

Again the primary goal is to address the unique factors that contribute to Suisun City's high percentage of overweight or obese youth, among other chronic health concerns.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SUISUN CITY AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS RELATED TO SUISUN CITY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE PARTNERSHIPS TO IMPROVE COMMUNITY HEALTH (PICH) GRANT

WHEREAS, Solano County has the highest rate of diabetes (9.8%) as compared to California (7.72%) and the United States (8.95%); and

WHEREAS, Suisun City has the highest rate of childhood overweight/obesity (46.3%) of all Solano County cities, Solano County (38.4%) and the State of California (38.0%); and

WHEREAS, Solano County Health & Social Services was awarded the Partnerships to Improve Community Health (PICH) grant in the amount of \$1.2 million a year for three years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Suisun has the opportunity to participate in the PICH grant with a budget of \$150,930 for the first full year of the grant period in order to undertake work tasks that develop and implement policies that are specific to the needs and interests of Suisun City that will increase access to and choice by residents of smoke-free/tobacco-free environments, as well as healthy food and/or beverage options.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Suisun City authorizes the City Manager to execute necessary documents related to Suisun City's participation in the Partnerships to Improve Community Health (PICH) grant.
