

MARINA & WATERFRONT



The Suisun City Marina is a completely modern harbor with 160 berthing slips, a 300 foot guest dock, and free public boat launch ramps at the south end of the marina. The Harbormaster Office is conveniently located adjacent to the Marina at 800 Kellogg St.

The Suisun Channel provides direct access to the waterways of the California Delta and San Francisco Bay. The slough winds through the Suisun Marsh where it feeds into Grizzly Bay. The Suisun Channel and marsh boast outstanding sturgeon and striped bass fishing, sight-seeing, bird-watching, boating, and plenty of water activities.

AMENITIES

The Marina offers a variety of amenities including a free waste pump out station, a fuel station and a free 24-hour public launch ramp. The Marina's fuel station is on the south end of the Marina and dispenses unleaded fuel and diesel. The Marina also has a guest dock and guest berths for boaters boating into Suisun City from other harbors. Visitors may enjoy restaurants, special events and other amenities all available within walking distance in the Waterfront District.
